- Software/Curriculum/Academic Support Needs for 2023-24
 - Learning A-Z Not widely used (only used by 4 teachers at HPE K and 1st). Proposal to get only 2-4 licenses.
 - Imagine Learning Math This helps the students who aren't ready for iReady. This helps to bridge the gap – used by K-2, ESOL, SPED. Not requesting Math Facts for next year.
 - Reflex Math County has approved for this year.
 - o Pebble Go 1st/2nd Used during Science/Social Studies
 - Flocabulary Primarily 5th. 1st/3rd/4th used for whole groups when introducing a new topic.
 - Generation Genius 5th only, used to frontload information. 1 license only, shared by the team. Could be paid for out of 5th grade funds.
 - Write Score K-2nd, SPED focus (county provides 3rd-5th access). Provides lessons for the teachers, graphic organizers for the students, how to break down writing.



- Do The Math Intervention workbook for K-5th EIP, SPED
- Decodable Readers K-5th Supplement what we have in supply need more short vowels, beginning blends (confirmed can't purchased with Scholastic Dollars)
- Primary Journals K-2nd These are hard to find, so don't want to rely on school supply list. Need to order 350 journals.
