  - Principals Update (Dr Miller)
    - Remote Learning transition in and out was positive and smooth
    - IREADY RESULTS
      - o 20% increase overall in Iready reading
      - $\circ~~$  55% on or above grade level in Iready reading
      - $\circ$  54% of students in special education moved up a level in reading
      - o 19% increase overall in Iready math
      - o 44% on or above grade level in Iready reading
      - $\circ$  50% of students in special education moved up a level in math
    - 16 new students
    - 1 teacher retired, found good replacement
    - Covid mitigation staying same as of right now
    - Planning to move ahead with everything on schedule, just some change of dates(Including Rock Eagle)
    - 1<sup>st</sup> outdoor classroom complete
      - Have experience in making decisions and so easier to move forward with future projects
      - Adding to the structure to make it more user friendly
